LOGISTIC

Airport – Y.C.M. Shuttle

The Yacht Club de Monaco's valet service will be responsible for team transfers from Nice airport (NCE) to/from the YCM for each team arriving by plane (4 competitors and 1 coach).

Minibus / Car Park

To assist you driving to the trailer park using the widest roads available, you may download a picture document of each crossroad from the motorway to “Esplanade des Pêcheurs”.

Boat Bus

To access your vehicle in the Car Park from the Yacht Club, you can take the “Bateau Bus” that crosses the harbor.

The crossing will be free of charge on presentation of the badge which will be given to you on confirmation of your registration.

Optimist Storage

Optimists will be assigned by country to specific zones.

Competitors are asked to respect these zones by leaving the path to the slipway clear. Access to the slipway will be in the order of the first matches of the day and will be announced by the Beach Marshall.

Sail Storage

The sails can be stored rigged overnight in the boat shed, where storage systems will be in place.

Changing Room

Changing rooms with toilets and showers are available at the sailing school.

Monaco and the Yacht Club are relatively safe places, but we would like to draw your attention to the fact that personal belongings may not be left in the changing rooms and that it is the responsibility of each team to look after their belongings, especially valuables.



Team Support (Mailbox)

Registration Desk

The Registration Desk is located in the Atrium (YCM Main Entrance – Quai Level), in front of the podium on Quai Louis II.

The day of your arrival, **all teams must confirm their registration at the registration desk** where all relevant information will be given. Upon the team's arrival, each member will receive a welcome pack including a personal badge permitting access to the different specific areas.

You will receive it at the YCM main entrance, from the registration desk once you have confirmed your registration.

Accommodation

All the teams will be staying in flats at the Aparthotel Adagio Monte-Cristo, just a 12-minute walk from the YCM.

Emergency and Medical Care

If you need emergency assistance throughout the championship (24/7), please contact the organizer, Thomas Champion, on +377.93.10.75.32.

➤ **Monegasque Red Cross Advanced Post**

Volunteers from the Monegasque Red Cross will be on hand from the 15th to 19th of October (from 9.00 am to 6.00 pm), so don't hesitate to call on them if you need assistance.

They will be stationed in the sailing school infirmary, near the changing rooms.

➤ **Pharmacy**

Currency and Electrical Outlet

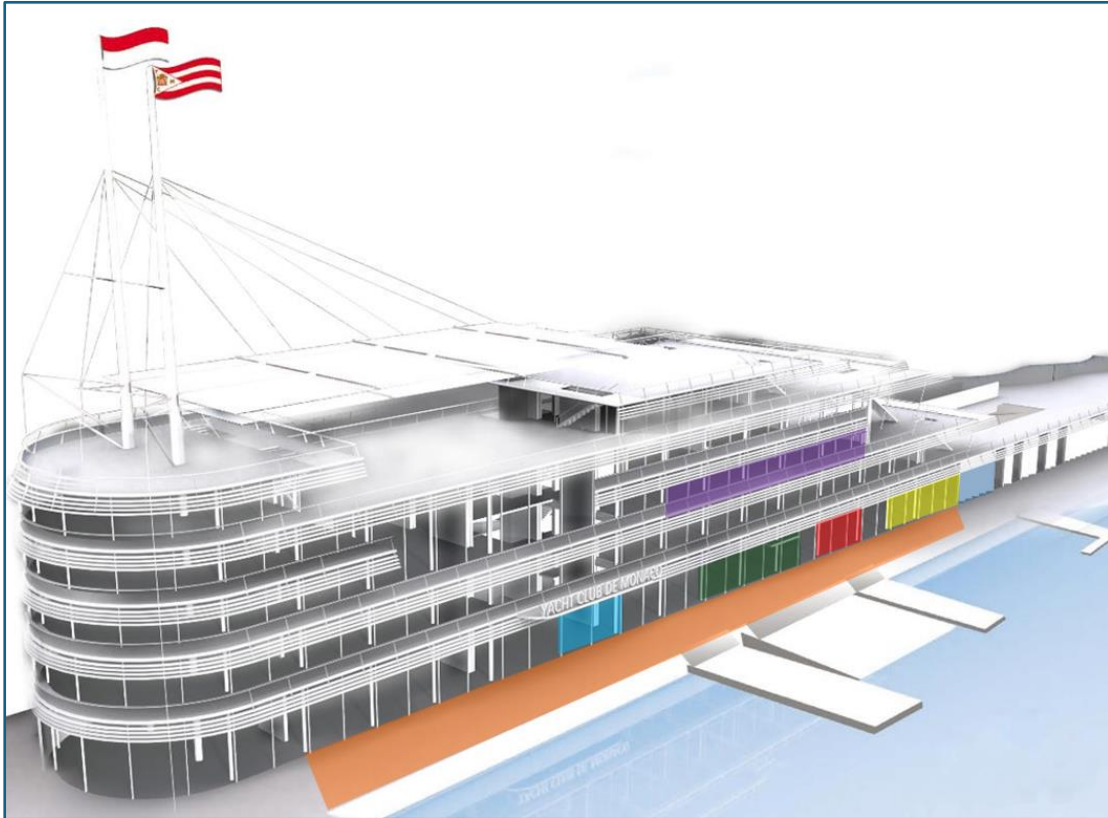
In France and Monaco, the currency is the Euro (EUR).

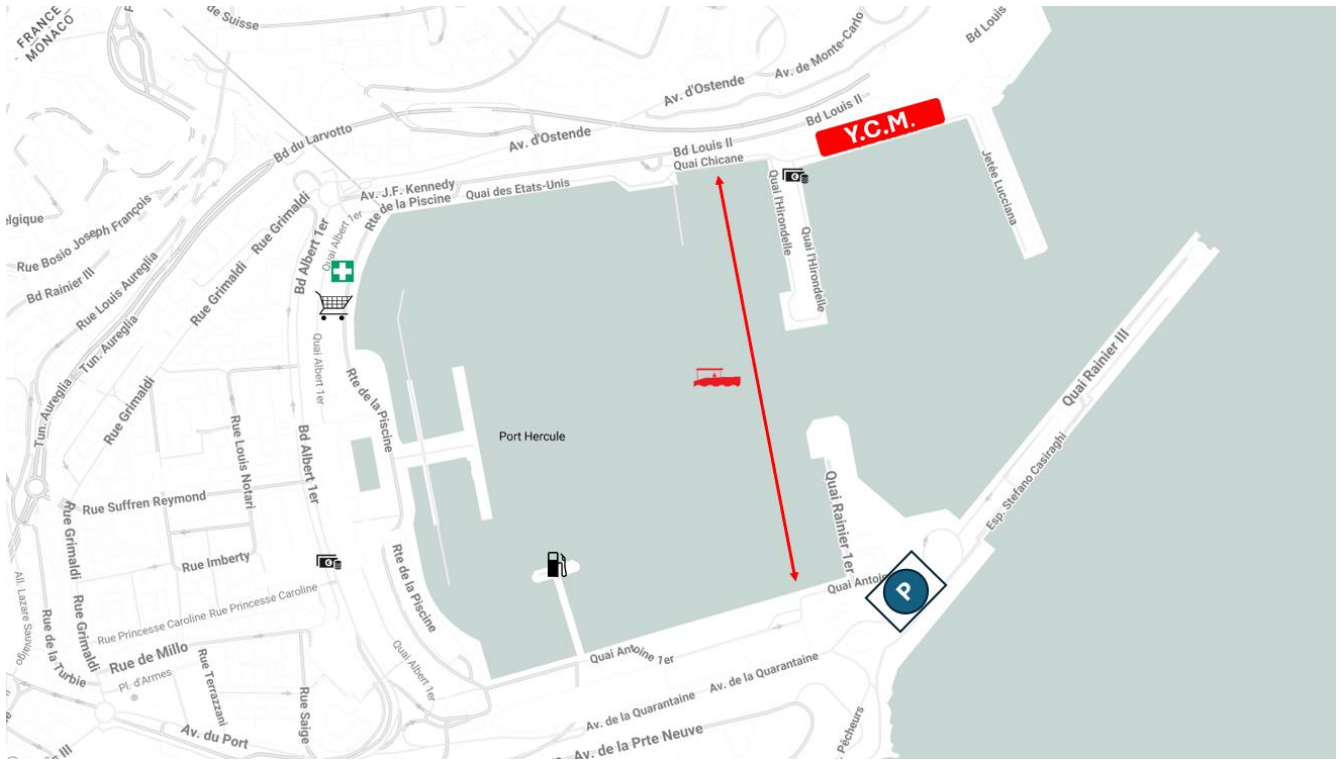
Blueprint of the Yacht Club de Monaco

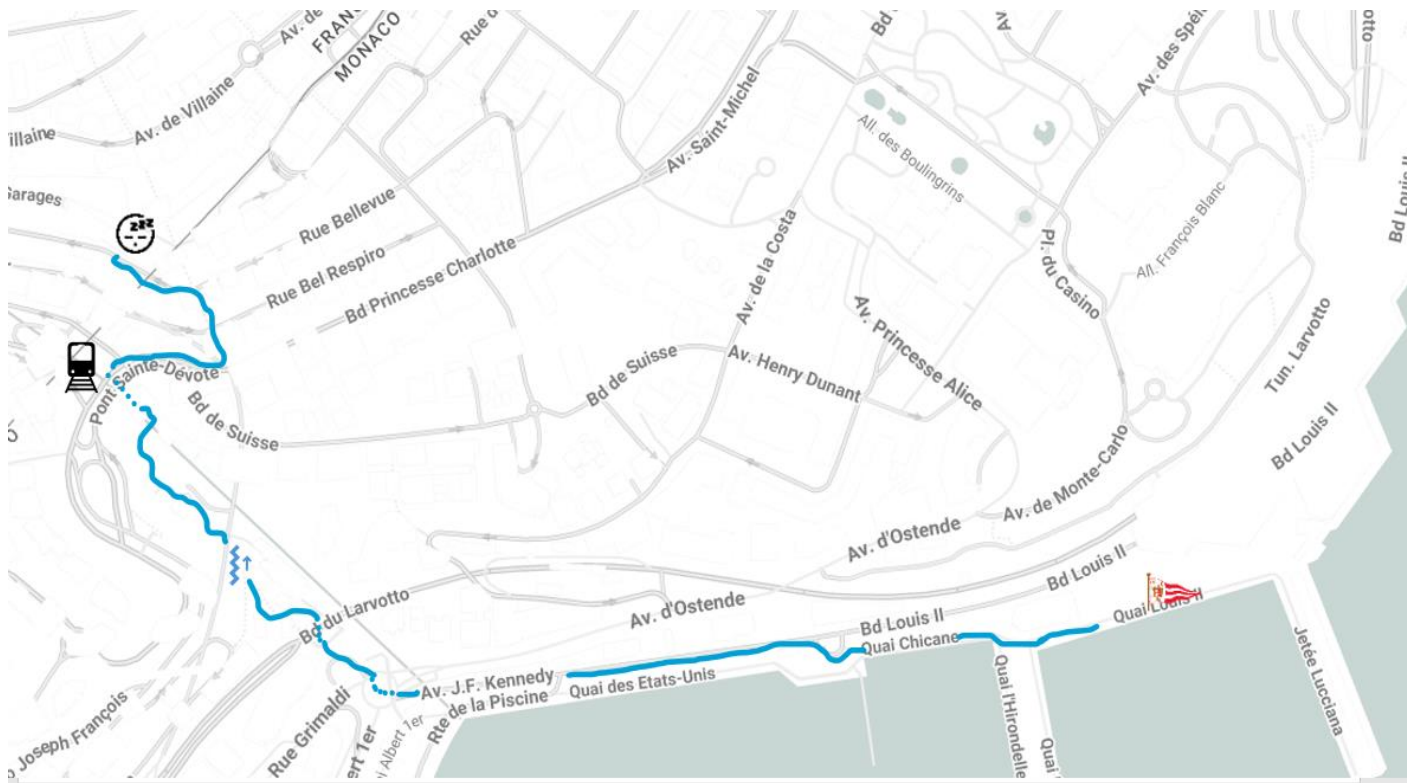
